President-Elect Two-Year Term

The president-elect shall carry out duties as assigned by the President; shall act in the absence of the President; shall prepare to assume the office of the president.

The PRESIDENT-ELECT shall:

- 1. Attend all IPAC NWO Chapter and Executive meetings.
- 2. Serve as parliamentarian.
- 3. Prepare to assume the Office of President after two years or as required in the event that the President is unable to fulfill his/her term.
- 4. Chair meetings in absence of the President.
- 5. Ensure revision of Terms of Reference.
- 6. Solicit and prepare Chapter news for publication in the Canadian Journal of Infection Control.
- 7. May attend IPAC Canada President's meeting at the Annual Conference in the absence of the President.
